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THE LENTEN FAST.

The rules which have just been issued by the Roman Catholic Archbishop for the observance of the Lenten fast are interesting as denoting the gradual adjustment of the church canons to the dictates of dietetic science.

In the early days of the church "abstinence" was required during Lent and on fast days, but the meaning of "abstinence" was left to the discretion of the local priests.

In 1857, by special dispensation, the Pope ordered the Roman Catholic clergy to abstain on every day in Lent, except on Wednesdays, Fridays and two Saturdays; also to eat butter, cheese, milk and eggs at lunch every day.
