The Illinois Central Railroad to Water Its Capital. New York, Aug. 11.—A. G. Heckstaff, secretary, has sent a letter to each holder of Illinois Central Railroad stock stating that the board of directors will submit at the annual meeting on October 15th a plan to increase the capital stock of the company from \$45,000,000 to \$50,000,000 by a new issue of five millions of 100 each. Each stockholder of record on September 20 is for one share or for any nine shares then registered in his name.

PLOTTING TO KILL.

An Alleged Conspiracy to Murder Frick Discovered by the Police.

PITTSBURGH, Aug. 11.—The Post will publish a story in the morning to the effect that the police have discovered another anarchist plot to assassinate Frick. The assassin is an anarchist named Aaronstann of New York, who is a close friend of Bergman and Emma Goldman. Aaronstann has been in the city for several days, and it is claimed he has been plotting to kill Frick. Information was given to the police by an Austrian, who arrived in the city recently with letters from the high police officials of Vienna. The New York police at once notified the Pittsburgh authorities and a close watch for Aaronstann is being kept about all the anarchist resorts.

One of the Mailed Men Claims Heavy Damages. PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 11.—William R. Letar, a Philadelphia mail carrier, today announced that he had received heavy damages from the Pinkerton men on account of the Homestead riot. In his statement he says that he was employed by the Pinkerton men to act as watchman in certain buildings in the city of New York, to which he was sent by the Pinkerton men to conduct his office. SYMPATHY FROM LABORERS.

TRUBLE IN TREBIZOND.

Disturbance Over Enforcing Sanitary Regulations Against the Cholera. CONSTANTINOPLE, Aug. 11.—On the 5th inst. a serious disturbance broke out in Trebizond over the enforcement of sanitary regulations adopted by Turkish officials against cholera. Nearly 1500 persons were detained in the lazareto, and they attempted to break through the sanitary cordons. Soldiers were summoned to quell the disturbance, and at the first volley seven persons were killed and many others wounded. The people were panic-stricken, and fled back to the lazareto.
