THE BELGIAN CHINESE.

Over One Hundred Portland Certificates Disclosed on Board. Collector Phelps has allowed 235 Chinese on the steamer Belgica to land, as they were properly accredited exhibitors at the World's Fair. It is not supposed that there is any opinion on the Belgica, as she did not stop at any of the islands in the collector's office that the exhibiting Chinese who passed through San Francisco to the World's Fair are allowed a right to go to Chicago, so that the actors coming from Vancouver should not be permitted to land.
