The feature of the week's racing was undoubtedly the consistent running of horses according to their most recent form. The talent of the California horses in their tussle with the bookmakers. The custom of not bidding for the winners of selling races, which had so far been almost entirely unknown in this country, was broken through in a most unexpected and sensational manner on Saturday, when E. Holly, who owned the second horse, Parmatta, in the second race of the day, bid for the winner, \$1500 above the sum that was entered to be sold, and Mr. Williams in order to return he was compelled to go another \$100, Holly and the association being thus \$2500 ahead of the bookmakers.

Joe Narvaez returned on Saturday from St. Louis, where he had remarkable success in his racing home, having shown eight winners, and wherever he has appeared he has shown the public the kind of jockey that California can turn out. He is without a doubt the finest jockey in the country, and his presence on the track seems to be the general wish of the public.

His colt Zebra showed very good form in his race on Friday against Fidella and Charm, and in Orta, Belmont, Biomedie and the other races of the week.

Joe King has applied to the board of the Woodland Racing Association for reinstatement with good prospect of success. The program for this week is an exceedingly good one. Two or more races will be decided, and big fields may be looked for. Lovers of races hope, however, that so big a field as that on Saturday in the five-furlong race will not be permitted. Starting at 1:30 p. m. practically, six races could be given to the benefit of the public no less than to the advantage of the association in an increase of revenue.
