

RUNNING RACES.

A Sensation for People at the Track.

BREAKDOWN OF MORELLO.

Don Fulano Wins the Big Stake Event.

THE TALENT BREAK ABOUT EVEN.

Inkerman, Romair, El Dorado and Romulus Prove the Winners in the Ordinary Events.

The certainty of Morello's appearance in the Rancho de Paso stakes, of the guaranteed value of \$1500, of which \$250 went to the second and \$100 to the third, distance one mile and a furlong, attracted a very large crowd to the Bay District track yesterday afternoon, and those in search of a sensation were not disappointed in their quest.

The defeat of Morello in the race, which was looked upon as nothing more than an exercise gallop for him, and his breaking down in the early part of it long before he was asked the question, was practically no race, as the struggle between the leaders had not then commenced, furnished the sensational incidents. The amount of applause bestowed on Don Fulano and Charmon as the horses went to the post anticipated the noise that arose when it was seen that the favorite was beaten. The bookmakers, with one or two exceptions, who were hard hit over Don Fulano, must have had a rare clean-up over the race, for there were people out at the track yesterday who had never bet a dollar in their lives who had been inveigled into going out to pick up money by laying as high as 4 and 5 to 1 on the great favorite.

Tom Williams was among the lucky few who backed Don Fulano to win in the face of everything, having put a cool thousand on him at odds of 1 to 1. This is evidence of great regard for the favorite, and his ability to defeat a horse who is considered the greatest in America to-day, and who has given better horses than Don Fulano thirty pounds and a beating.

Morello's owner, who was seen by a representative of THE CALL after the race, stated that the breaking down was probably due to an injury received on going round the first turn, where the horse seemed to wrench an ankle, and that it was merely of a temporary character. It is pretty certain that Van Ness does not think badly of the accident, and is confident that Morello will get over it.

Charmon's running in this race was not at all satisfactory. When it is remembered how she won her last race against Don Fulano the pursuance of the same tactics in the present occasion would have seemed the wisest and most profitable course. As it was she was restrained the first part of the journey and Don Fulano was allowed to make his own running solo.

Every horseman cannot but feel a pang of regret that Morello should have met with defeat from opponents so unworthily to measure strides with him. Mention is made in an Eastern turf journal that Morello is to be retired to the shed next week in California, and that the owner, his no verification can be given to the report.
