No action has been taken by officials of the Midwinter Fair regarding the impromptu entrance to the park, the expense of collecting 10 cents from each person admitted to keep out. Neither guards nor civic policemen interfered with this little concession which kept money out of the exposition treasury, and which was maintained all day during the greatest fete of the fair.

That it was a profitable undertaking is evidenced by the fact that one of the promoters celebrated his illegal project by drinking repeatedly to his own cleverness on Monday, freely exhibiting handfuls of dimes and nickels, which he stated had been received as admittance fees. While in his cups he described his mode of operation, and at that time he admitted every one who would listen to him that his confederates, who he said were guards and a local policeman, had not given him his share of the proceeds.

Captain George Baldwin of the Midwinter Guards denied all knowledge of this private entrance and discredited the story of E. A. Felder, chief of the department of admissions, frankly admitted its truth. The Midwinter Fair was plainly defrauded of many dollars, yet no action was taken to bring the culprits to justice, to discipline the guards if guilty, or to exonerate them if innocent of the charge of complicity.

Officers of the administration have been exceedingly lukewarm regarding the affair. They began an investigation in a half-hearted way, but did not push it to a conclusion. Chief of Police Charles H. Young, who is usually so prompt in his action, seemed disinclined to take any measures which might implicate an employee of the administration.

Some one suggested to place protecting arms around the pretty blue uniforms, brass buttons and tassels of the guards. They are undeniably beautiful, these guardians of the market, and with a few dimes and pennies, but they do not interfere with spictees who insult visitors on the midway, and when charges of operating a private entrance are made, they do not ostentatiously commence an investigation, but drop all inquiry as soon as the scent becomes strong.

The 40 Miting Camp has been closed for the past two days. It is intimated that this typically pioneer concession will not reopen unless new terms are secured from the executive committee, and the terms exacted by the management being considered too high by the concessionaires.

When Gold Gulch camp was first conceived a side transaction was made by Carson City, that humorous individual joyfully admitted that he had no money to pay for space on the fair grounds. So he drew a deposit, the amount of ten per cent commission on his receipts, instead of the 15 per cent paid by concessionaires who had made a cash payment for space. This transaction was entered into a corporation, which has continued the same terms until Tuesday.
