OUR TRIP TO STATE FAIR

To the Public: Sir ce the return of the boys and girls from the State Fair, I have been questioned many times as to the why and how of the trip. 1 being put forward by the Extension Department of the N. M. College of Agriculture and Mechanical Arts.

The United States Government, realizing the great work done by the corn and canning clubs in various states, bus provided leaders from each agricultural college to develope in the homes the industrial activities of the boys and girls. "Projects" of raising field crops, vegerables poultry, hogs, and the canning of fruits and vegerables, sewing and baking have been formulated and Prof. T W. Conway and Miss Dorn Edon Ross of the A & M College have travelled over the state explaining and interesting the children to work out a project under the direction for the Boys' and Girle' Industrial

To awaken interest in this work, the State Fair Association, approprinted w thousand dollars to entertain ten hoys and girls of each county at a state encampment during the State Fair with Cap: J. H. Toulouse in charge.

Not a cent of expense for entertainment was expected of a delegate from the time he stepped off the train at Albuquerque: in our county, the local committee of the fair appropriated fifty dollars and Blanchard Bros donated ten dollars toward the railroad fare of delegates. Three boys and three girls were taken with this sum, parents of the others paying the railroad

Each morning the club leaders gave instruction in industrial subjects and in methods of the club Exhibits of what had been done this year by club members were shown and the delegates were sent abroad to all parts of the state to tell of what had been and what could be accomplished by any child in his own ho ne.

Another year the delegates will he those who have faithfully worked out a project, and who will have exhibited a sample of the completed wonderful trip being in the nature of a prime to the faithful. Address Prof. T. W. Conway, State College, as to details of the work.
