HOW THE FLORIDA GAME LAWS READ

SOMETHING ABOUT THEIR LIMITATION AND PROSCRIPTIONS.

Non-Residents Must Pay License for Privilege Of Hunting Within Borders of the State.

With the approaching game season it will probably be of interest to sportsmen generally to know just what the law is relating to game. Just now, when the closed season is about at an end, violations of the law are most numerous.

Under the laws of this State it is illegal to hunt, chase, kill or molest any wild deer, except during the months of November, December and January. The law provides a maximum fine of \$100, or imprisonment for six months.

It is equally unlawful to have deer meat in one's possession during the closed season. In addition to this the law is very explicit in regard to selling the flesh or hides or shipping same from State.

GAME BIRDS

When it comes to game birds, especially turkey and quail, the law is very clear just how many birds of each species may be killed by a single hunter, and the number which a party of two or more persons may kill in a day's hunt. Here is the law:

"No person or persons shall have in his, her or their possession, or shall hunt or kill any wild turkey or quail or partridge in any part of this State, save only from the first day of November until the first day of March of any year. No person shall kill more than two wild turkeys, nor more than twenty quails, and no party of two or more persons shall kill more than four wild turkeys or more than forty quail in any one day. And no person shall kill more than five wild turkeys in any one year, and no person or persons, firm, corporation, association or company shall sell, expose for sale or have in his, her or their possession for sale in this State, any wild turkey, quail or partridge. Any person or persons, corporation, association or company violating any of the provisions or company violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 or more than \$100, or be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding 60 days or less than 30 days."

May Shoot Ducks Now

It is legal to shoot ducks from October 1 to March 30. If shot at any other season of the year the person so doing is liable to a heavy fine.

One section of the law provides that it shall be unlawful to kill, catch or have in your possession, living or dead, any wild bird other than a game bird. No part of the plume, skin or body of any bird protected by this section may be sold or had in possession for sale. Only the following are considered game birds: Swan, geese, brant, river and sea ducks, rails, coots, mud hens, gallinules; the semicola, commonly known as show birds, plover, surf birds, snipe, woodcock, sandpipers, tattlers and curlews; wild turkey, grouse, prairie chicken, pheasants, partridges and quails; also turtle doves and wild pigeons and robins. It is unlawful to destroy the nest or eggs of a wild

bird or have either in one's possession.

Unprotected Birds

Birds which are not included in this section and are unprotected are:

The English sparrow, sharp-shinned hawk, commonly known as the little blue darter; Cooper's hawk, commonly known as the big blue darter; great horned owl, crow, rice bird, meadow lark, jackdaw and butcher bird are not included among the birds protected by the two preceding sections. Nothing in said sections shall prevent any citizen of the State of Florida from destroying birds which are found injuring grapes, fruits, gardens or farm products on his premises, or from taking and keeping in a cage any cardinal red bird or mocking bird for his own pleasure or amusement; provided the same shall not be sold or shipped out of the State.

A license is exacted from non residents who come here to hunt. The tax is \$10 for the season.
