TENNESSEE VOTES DRY.

Bill Passes Legislature to Go into Effect July 1st, of this Year.

Nashville, Tenn., Jan. 13.—The bill to prohibit the sale of intoxicating liquors in Tennessee passed the lower house of the legislature this evening by a vote of 62 to 36. Twenty-two republicans voted for and one against the measure. The bill passed is the one acted on favorably yesterday by the senate, and now goes to Gov. Patterson. He is expected to veto it, but under the constitution his veto only operates as a suggestion, not as a stay, and a bare majority may pass the bill over the executive veto. The governor is allowed to hold a bill five days, and if at the expiration of that time it has not been returned to the legislature it becomes a law without his signature. The bill provides that prohibition shall become effective July 1, 1909.

The undersigned subscribers to the capital stock of the herein afterwards named corporation, hereby give notice that they will apply to Hon. A. W. Gilchrist, Governor of the State of Florida, on the 8th day of February, A. D. 1909, for the issuance of Letters Patent incorporating them as a corporation to do business under the corporate name of Middle Florida Grocery Company, with a charter as herein afterwards set forth, a copy of which has this day been filed in the office of Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE FIRST.

The name of this corporation shall be Middle Florida Grocery Company, with its principal place of business at Live Oak, Suwannee county, Florida, and such other places of business within the United States as may be determined upon by the Board of Directors of this corporation.

ARTICLE SECOND.

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be exclusively a wholesale business, dealing principally in groceries, together with such other line of merchandise as the Board of Directors may from time to time decide upon not inconsistent with the laws of Florida, the conduct of the business to be to buy, sell and dispose of groceries, general merchandise, stocks and bonds, and such other lines of merchandise as aforesaid, exclusively by wholesale; to also buy, own, sell and dispose of real estate and such other business as is consistent with this charter and laws governing corporation of this character.

ARTICLE THIRD.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, divided into One Hundred shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share, and shall be paid into said corporation either in cash, goods, wares, merchandise, labor and services, or such other property as may be determined upon; the cash value of which shall be decided upon and appraised by the Board of Directors.

This corporation unless sooner dissolved by law shall exist for ninety-nine years.

ARTICLE FOURTH.

The business of this corporation shall be conducted by a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary and Treasurer, the last two of which offices may be held by one and the same person, and also by a Board of Directors composed of not less than three nor more than five who shall be stockholders; the regular annual meeting of the stockholders for the election of Directors shall be held on Tuesday after the fourth Monday in June of each year, at which time, or as soon thereafter as practical, said stockholders shall elect a Board of Directors, and said Board of Directors shall forthwith elect from the stockholders of said corporation a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary and Treasurer, and said directors shall make and adopt By-laws for the government of the affairs of said corporation; and until the first annual meeting of the stockholders of this corporation, G. H. Davis shall be President, F. R. McCormack, Vice-President and W. P. Walker, Secretary and Treasurer, and the three above officers shall constitute the Board of Directors, who shall administer and carry on the business of said corporation.

ARTICLE SIXTH.

The highest amount of indebtedness to which the corporation can at any time subject itself shall be the amount of its capital stock, to-wit: Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE SEVENTH.
