VIRGINIA HAS ALWAYS LED  
 In the Production of the Very Great Men of the Nation.

A writer in the New York World, reviewing Page's History of Virginia, had this to say: "No other land with a population relatively so small has ever produced so many great men in so short a time, Massachusetts excepted." Why the except unless it be a chunk of flat or chimney-corner history? We would not disparage Massachusetts, but in the roll of men of the very first class in our political and military history she and every other State must accept the primacy of the Old Dominion, our fine old neighbor just across the Potomac river.

The average American citizen believes—and all foreigners have been made to believe—that the pilgrim fathers of the Bradford and Carver regime, and the puritan fathers of the Winthrop and Endicott regime, made Anglo-Saxon America, when the fact is that Virginia did more in that behalf than the other twelve colonies combined.

Patrick Henry, "the forest-born Demosthenes, whose thunder shook the Philip of the seas," first proclaimed independence; Jefferson, the sanest political philosopher the world ever saw, penned the Declaration that asserted independence, and then "the world's only Washington" threw his sword into the balance and achieved independence.

Later Virginia set about to make the Union. That she did with the aid of the foreigner, Hamilton, and Ellsworth and Sherman, of New England. But there would have been no Union if the ten amendments invented by Patrick Henry and George Mason and proposed by Virginia, had not been accepted by the other States, and even then the constitution was a house of cards, to fall apart at the slightest rude touch, until John Marshall, another Virginian, cemented it in the concrete of his imperishable decisions as chief justice of the United States supreme court.

And when the tremendous test came that tried every soul in 1861, Virginia gave to the South and to history Robert E. Lee, Stonewall Jackson, Joseph E. Johnston, J. E. B. Stuart and Turner Ashby, and then in her lavish hospitality she gave the North George H. Thomas, the one undefeated Federal commander of the war, and by many regarded as endowed with more genius for arms than any of his fellows on his side. It is almost certain that had he been of northern birth he would have been appointed commander-in-chief.

Massachusetts is the mother of a great number of great men, but in that respect Virginia is first.—Washington Post.




