Coffins Ready for the Crew.
Honolulu, April 1.—Grapple cables attached to a heavy object, believed to be the lost submarine F-4, parted late yesterday, and work was suspended for the night. The spot was carefully marked so that another attempt could be made to grapple the object.
Twenty-one coffins have been delivered at the navy dock for the ill-fated crew of the F-4.

GOMPERS THINKS STRIKE WILL BE AVOIDED.
Chicago, April 3.—Samuel Gompers, president of the American Federation of Labor, expressed confidence yesterday that a general industrial tie-up in Chicago would be avoided, as a result of the agreement of striking painters and plasterers to submit their grievances to arbitration.
