J. Kukasky's store at St. Augustine was burglarized and a quantity of goods taken.

Pensacola has a charter amendment bill that has passed to its third reading in the Senate.

The United States court will convene in Pensacola May 8th, Judge Charles Swayne presiding.

Pensacola will now try the good roads demonstrator's work and have a number of streets improved.

Howard H. Roberts of Ocala went to Jacksonville too heavily armed and paid \$20 for totting concealed weapons.

Seventy-five potato pickers arrived at Hastings the fore part of the week, to help harvest the large crop of tubers.

Julian Johnson, a negro lad in jail at St. Augustine, charged with the murder of a companion, has been acquitted.

There were 59 cars of vegetables shipped from the vicinity of Miami last week. The total cash value was \$60,625.

Sixteen gamblers were marched up to the bar of justice at Marianna by Sheriff Lewis, who says the game must be stopped there.

P. J. McKenzie Oarting, who resides on the naval reservation near Pensacola, celebrated his 90th birthday anniversary April 24th.

Thos. J. Murray, engineer on the steamship Westover, was badly scalded at Tampa by the explosion of a steam pipe. The wounds are not thought to be dangerous.

As soon as the county seat election in Holmes county was decided in favor of Bonifay, a wagon was sent to Westville after the county records. But legal complications are expected.

The district conference of the Methodist Church, South, of the East Coast district, will meet at West Palm Beach May 28d to 29th. Rev. Fred Pasco, D. D., is presiding elder.

The Seaboard Air Line railway will dredge along their wharf at Fernandina and secure a depth of 24 feet of water at low tide. This will be of great benefit to their shipping facilities.

The union depot at Palatka is to receive much needed repairs and alterations. The Atlantic Coast Line will build separate waiting rooms for whites and blacks, with separate ticket windows.

**PROBABLY SETTLE IN GEORGIA.**

South African Boers with General Cronje Visiting United States. Norfolk, Va., April 27.—General Cronje who was a member of President Kruger's cabinet for 12 years and a noted Boer leader, and is now on a tour of America, was shown a copy of the new constitution today. He said:

"It is a breach of the treaty of peace made us by England who promised a self government as soon as our country was in a settled state.

"King Edward has been advised by the capitalists in the drawing up of this constitution which to my mind is no constitution at all. The only thing which remains to be done is to be patient and work with petitions to the British government. On hearing the remark that petition would not avail, he responded:

"If they trample them underfoot for ten years still they must listen to us some day.

"The people of the Transvaal have been forming a political organization under the Boer leaders known as the 'Hetvolk,' the people, who will demand what was promised them in the signing of the peace treaty.

"Under the new constitution capital will be arrayed against labor and there is no possibility of self government. The Briton now in South Africa is allied with the Boer and wants self government, and does not want the country to be ruled by capitalists and magnates."

The Boers and Britons who are now in America with Cronje, over 500 in all, have become reconciled to the extent of agreeing to colonize in America, probably in Georgia.

The Old Japanese Mail. In the days before the ports of Japan were opened to foreigners, before telegraphs, railroads and electricity had found their way into the island empire, the infrequent mails were carried by post runners, who wore the merest apology of a loin cloth and blue and white rag around their heads. They were for the most part an elaborate suit of tattoo, with a red star on each shoulder, the mark of their calling. The letters were incased in a waterproof package and secured to the end of a bamboo pole. With this over his shoulder and a pair of fragile sandals on his feet the runner started on his long journey, making from 75 to 100 miles per day. The distance they covered seems incredible, but the men were trained to speed and had remarkable endurance.
