

### DR. KELLEY ON SCHOOL QUESTION

Has Returned From Recent Inspection in West End.

SOME ARE GOOD, OTHERS NOT

The Superintendent Gives Reasons Why a School May or May Not be Prosperous—The Fault of Patron or Teacher, or Sometimes Both.

Dr. J. L. Kelley, Superintendent of Public Instruction of Alachua county, has just completed a tour of inspection of a number of the schools in the West End. He also visited the schools at Alachua, Micanopy and Hawthorn.

Dr. Kelley states that he found some schools in excellent condition, some "just medium," and some at a very low ebb of efficiency and discipline.

"I regret to report this state of affairs," remarked the Superintendent. "I would much prefer to say that all schools were flourishing, but if I did I would be misrepresenting conditions.

"There are several reasons why schools flourish and why they do not flourish. In a flourishing school you will always find the teacher a hard, earnest, conscientious but clever worker. He is a good disciplinarian, and the children learn to respect and obey him. On the other hand, a school that is not prosperous is entitled to a reason. It may be the fault or negligence of the teacher or it may be the indifference patrons of schools have in sending their children to the school-house regularly. It may be both. When a teacher observes, however, that the patrons of the school are indifferent, it is likely to make him indifferent also.

Trustees and Patrons Negligent.

"It is lamentable to note that patrons and trustees as a rule do not visit the schools regularly, which has a tendency to demoralize both the instructors and the pupils. I trust they will begin to realize the importance of their duty in this direction after a while and perform it.

"A number of schools are very well disciplined, while others have no discipline at all. From this date on the Board of Public Instruction proposes to demand discipline in all schools."

Majority of Schools Closed.

All schools in the county with the exception of ten or twelve have been closed. The remainder will close the latter part of May. The schools at Dutton and Brown, however, will run



The Board at its meeting Tuesday retired a considerable number of school warrants anti-dating July, 1903.

DIED TO SAVE BROTHER.

Philadelphia Boy Killed by Engine in Act of Saving His Brother.  
Philadelphia, May 2.—Edward Hendrickson, 11 years old, of No. 121 1/2 tan street, sacrificed his life under the wheels of a locomotive to save his 5-year-old brother, Gilbert, from injury. The boys were walking along the Baltimore and Ohio railroad tracks at Stonehouse lane and Weccacoe avenue when the younger brother stepped to another track in front of an approaching train.

Edward quickly realized his brother's danger. He jumped toward him, pushing him down a small embankment. The locomotive struck Edward and the wheels passed over his body.

When the engineer stopped the train and the crew ran back, they found Gilbert bending over the mangled body of his older brother. He had been instantly killed.
