

THE TENOR SINGER FOUND.

Some say that After Proper Instruction He Will Startle World.
New York, Oct. 6.—In the person of Isaac Routman, an humble street musician of the East Side, and who is a young compatriot of Jean De Reszke, the famous Polish singer. It is believed that a great tenor has been accidentally found who will electrify the dramatic world that will rank with Messrs. Caruso and De Reszke.
"After a course of proper instruction," says Dr. H. Holbrook Curtis, an authority on the voice, and who made the "find," "I believe he will rank some day with our greatest tenors."
"He is marvelously gifted," says Miss Fritz Scheff, who has sung with all the great tenors of the world, "and he will equal Caruso or De Reszke. He shall have a stage name—Caruske, a combination of Caruso and De Reszke, for he will equal them both," and as Raphael Caruske young Routman has passed into the care of Charles Dillingham, Miss Scheff's manager, who will educate him for the operatic stage.

400 ARE RENDERED HOMELESS.

Big Fire in Lumber District of Wisconsin Destroys Property.
Rhinelander, Wis., Oct. 6.—Fire in the lumber district of this town destroyed property valued at \$600,000 and rendered 400 people homeless. The fire started in the lumber yard of the Brown Bros. Lumber company, and after sweeping that yard clean, it spread to the Robins Lumber company's yards, which were entirely destroyed. A high wind was blowing, which carried the fire into the residence district adjoining the lumber yards, destroying about 75 small dwelling houses. About 40,000,000 feet of lumber was destroyed.
The homeless people are being cared for tonight in the city hall and other buildings.
The total insurance is about \$400,000.
The principal losers are Brown Bros. Lumber company, lumber, \$250,000; insurance, \$175,000. Robins Lumber company, \$225,000; insurance, \$105,000. Two school houses and engine houses, \$25,000.
The loss on dwelling houses is about \$75,000.

Winding Out Inefficient Officers.

St. Petersburg, Oct. 6.—Inefficient officers are to be gradually weeded out of the Russian navy during the next five years and pensioned off to make way for better trained men to command the reconstruction of the navy. In a rescript addressed to the minister of marine, Emperor Nicholas directed that to compulsorily retire all naval officers who are unable to fulfill the higher requirements which the projected reforms in the service will demand. Officers retired before reaching the age limit, are to be pensioned on favorable conditions to be determined upon later.

AN ORDINANCE.

An Ordinance to Provide for the Fixing of Water Rates and the Collection of Same.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gainesville, Florida:

Section 1. The Tax Collector of the City of Gainesville is hereby designated and he shall be the person whose duty it is to collect from all persons, firms and corporations using city water, the rent for same. The City Council shall have authority to prescribe and enforce by resolution all necessary rules and regulations governing and controlling the use of city water, the manner in which same may be used and the amount to be charged for the use of same and when payable, and shall by resolution prescribe all rules and regulations of whatsoever kind for the complete control and management of the water supply and the furnishing of same for any and all purposes.

Sec. 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall take effect from its passage and approval.
