

GYPSIES ARE A NUISANCE.

Swindled a Merchant of \$65 in Cash On a Horse Trade... The band of Gypsies which has been in Gainesville for the past four or five days, and which has caused our citizens and business men no end of annoyance by their practices, are still making offensive trades and deals, and, as The Sun has already suggested, should be stopped.

Marshal Pinkson states that on Thursday he served upon these people a replevin paper to regain possession of a horse which they had traded to S. F. Brooks, the merchant. Mr. Brooks wanted a certain mule which was the property of the Gypsies. The animal was a heavy one, especially adapted to delivery work, and was represented to be in first-class condition.

When Mr. Brooks tried to work the mule in harness he found a serious defect, as the animal was what is commonly termed a "choker," meaning in effect that the mule was suffering with a throat affection, and when a collar was placed around his neck and a load applied, he would become choked and unfit for service.

Mr. Brooks, it is understood, endeavored to straighten the matter out with the Gypsies, but could get no satisfaction. The result was that he was compelled to sue by writ of replevin. Marshal Pinkson secured possession of the horse, but was unable to get the \$65 which was paid in the trade.

This "gang" is a nuisance, and should be made to leave the city. The local authorities would not think of tolerating such disreputable action from an American citizen, and anyone who attempted it would be in the chingang in forty-eight hours.
