

## MR. GAY MAKING A BIG SUCCESS

Manager of Colson Farm Secured Large Prizes for Products.

HANDSOME OFFER REFUSED

A Cash Proposition of \$4,000 for Crop of Ninety Acres of Cantaloupes on the Vines Refused, Because the Grower Expects Crop to Bring More.

W. F. Gay, manager of the extensive Colson farm at Arredondo, has demonstrated that he knew a few things practical in regard to farming, as he has made an excellent success of the farm, which is one of the best in the county.

From a small tract of one and one-half acres, Mr. Gay has already shipped 900 crates of cucumbers which have brought in the markets on an average of more than \$1 per crate, and before the season closes he expects to ship about 1,400 crates. This is a pretty fair profit on the acre and a half of land, and friends of Mr. Gay are congratulating him upon his success with the cucumber crop.

Mr. Gay has ninety acres of cantaloupes, from which he expects to realize handsomely. He has refused a cash offer of \$4,000 for the crop on the vines, and calculates on getting a great deal more, as the fruit is fine and even, of excellent quality, and is destined to bring fine prices in the Northern markets.

Mr. Gay is not only a practical planter, but a man of fine practical judgment, and this combination is proving very advantageous to him. He calculates on making a handsome thing financially from the farm this year, and while others may fall short on their expectations, he realizes that he will secure a fine success, because he has conducted his farm on a clear and practical basis.
