

MOTHER LED MOB.

Went to Wreak Vengeance on Men Who Killed Son.

New York, Sept. 18.—After Harry Breaker had been killed and Samuel Breaker, his brother, had been mortally wounded by Francesco Slocca, a young Italian, Monday night, two detectives had a desperate fight with a mob led by the young men's mother and bent on lynching the assailant of the two young men, and it was only after the detectives' clothes had been torn to shreds and their prisoner badly beaten, that the three were rescued by the police reserves.

The Breaker brothers were proprietors of a hardware store in "Little Italy." The police say Slocca, who is 20 years of age, and a bootblack, on Monday purchased a revolver at the store. He returned and wanted his money back a short while afterwards, saying the revolver was not satisfactory. His demand was refused, and he opened fire.

Detectives rushed into the store and grappled with the Italian before he could fire the last shot in his pistol into the prostrate body of Samuel Breaker. The Italian fought fiercely. A great crowd gathered and made an attempt to take the prisoner from the detectives. At the head of the mob was the aged mother of the Breaker boys, who was armed with an ax, and in her frenzy demanded that she be allowed to wreak vengeance on the slayer of her sons.

Added Gambling Den.

Atlanta, Ga., Sept. 18.—A gambling den on Broad street was raided Monday night by Sergeants Hatcher and Perkins and Private Stevens, of the Atlanta police force. More than fifty negroes were caught seated around gambling tables. The three officers made the raid unexpectedly and had no reinforcements at hand. The police say it was the largest number of gamblers they had ever seen gathered together in Augusta.

L. & N. NEW RATE LAW.

Comer Says Rebate Offered on Tickets Does Not Comply with Law.

Birmingham, Ala., Sept. 17.—The Louisville and Nashville railroad in seeking to comply with the new two and a half cent passenger rate laws in this state, has begun the sale of tickets within Alabama with coupons attached which entitle the passenger to a rebate of half a cent a mile in case the suit which the railroad has brought against the state railroad commission to prevent the enforcement of the new law is decided against it.

Governor Comer said that this does not meet the situation and will not be accepted by the state administration: as compliance with the law.

Three weeks ago the governor announced that unless the Louisville & Nashville and other roads adopted the new rates as most of the roads in the state have done, he would call the legislature in extra session after October 1 to take steps in the premises.

It is supposed that the action of the Louisville and Nashville was taken to technically comply with the law. The price of its tickets continues at three cents.

MISSISSIPPI PROMI FIGHT.

Fifty-Six Baptist Associations Notify Saloon Towns Their Day Has Come.

Jackson, Miss., Sept. 17.—Those five or six Mississippi counties where, in sale of whisky continues to be legalized might just as well make up their minds to surrender to the prohibition army, as death and taxes are little more certain than this state will declare for statutory prohibition when the legislature meets next January.

The fifty-six Baptist associations of the state are now being held, and some of them have already adopted resolutions calling the saloon towns by name and serving notice on them that their days are numbered. Vicksburg, Greenville, Natchez, Biloxi, Gulfport and Scranton are the principal offenders.

During the winter the Methodist conference and other religious bodies will meet and they will also memorialize the legislature to put a lock on what they denigrate "these places of sin and Luvian destruction."

Cotton Breaks Many Points.

New York, Sept. 18.—A sensational decline in the price of cotton took place amid excited trading on the New York cotton exchange Monday afternoon. As a result the October option sold under 11 cents a pound for the first time since last June, when prices were advanced on a bad crop report. Declines in the trading lam in the afternoon reached 52 to 55 points, or about \$2.50 below the closing prices of Saturday night and \$7.50 a bale below the high September.
