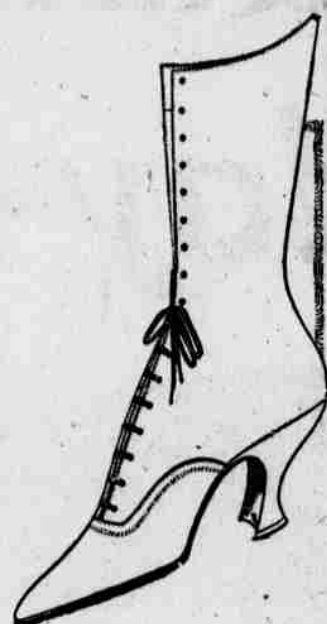

The young man had reached Lakeland in safety and made application at the local recruiting station for admittance to the army. The recruiting station was sending him on to Jacksonville and he was at the depot awaiting his train when the arrest was made. The young man stoutly denied his identity until confronted by Chief Allen who was prepared to make a personal identification. He does not deny the killing for which he was being held in Brooksville.
