Immediately after being bitten he suffered great pain, which ex tended from his foot up to hi houlder and continued through ill of Saturday. His foot and leg becanie greatly swollen and frou Saturday until Sunday noon he suffered from nausea. Most of these symptoms passed away by Sunday night and by Tuesday Dr . Trout was almost completely relieved.
To the fact that the snake was young and small and that its bite was promptly and correctly treated may be attributed the fact that Dr. Tront escaped with his life. bim from attemping trips into the Everglades.
