



Platform of H. J. Drane - Candidate for Congress



When one becomes a candidate for public office it is the custom to declare the principles for which he stands, and which, if elected, he will endeavor to maintain.

Following that custom, in my candidacy for the office of Representative in Congress, I declare the following as among the more important of my beliefs, and as looking to the greatest good, the greatest happiness, the greatest prosperity of the people of Florida:

The lowest Tariff consistent with a business-like and economical administration of the affairs of the Government. This Tariff to be highest upon luxuries and lowest upon necessities. Among the greatest luxuries and entitled to the highest Protective Tariff, I would name Citrus Fruits; favoring a restoration of the Tariff on Citrus Fruits to what it was before the present Tariff was adopted.

I believe that the question of tariff should be non-partisan; that it should be taken out of politics and that the interests of the people could best be served by placing it in the hands of a Commission of wise and patriotic men.

I believe that the Nation should at all times have desire for peace with all the world, so far as is consistent with National honor and self-respect; and that one of the greatest factors in maintaining permanent peace is National Preparedness to defend the People from wrongful aggression.

I believe that one of the greatest factors in National Preparedness is a vast system of permanent Military Highways throughout the States and connecting each State with the other in an unbroken chain from Atlantic to Pacific and from Great Lakes to Gulf.

I believe the National Guard should always be kept at its highest efficiency in men and equipment and that the Government should deal liberally with this branch of its service.

I believe we should have our own Merchant Marine and declare our independence of Foreign ships in transporting the fruits of our industry to the markets of the world.

I believe we should adhere strictly to the wise counsels of the Fathers and thus maintain absolute separation of Church and State. At the same time I would accord to every man in his private life the right to "worship God according to the dictates of his own conscience, with none to molest or make afraid."

I believe the final solution of the Prohibition question to be National Prohibition; and as I have consistently worked and voted for State-wide Prohibition, so I would if opportunity were afforded me, vote for National Prohibition, also.

I believe there should be rigid Immigration Laws with a Literary qualification and thus protect American workingmen and American society against the undesirable Immigration from European countries.

I believe the Government can best promote the interests of all the people, by extending the operations of the Federal Reserve Banks and providing long loans at low interest to industrious farmers, for the actual building up of the farm lands of the Nation.

The same system of extension should be applied also to Parcels Post on Farm Products.

I believe that Labor and Capital are both necessary to the happiness and prosperity of the Nation; that they are dependent each upon the other and therefore can and should work in utmost harmony. And,

Finally: I believe that with the magnificent natural waterways of Southern Florida; with their geographical location with relation to the Panama Canal, that these waterways should have more liberal treatment at the hands of the Federal Government than they have been accustomed to receive.

I believe the great commercial ports of Southern Florida should have an active and aggressive championship at Washington and that with such a championship Tampa would be destined, in time, to be one of the great Naval Bases of the Nation, thus providing commerce and protection for the entire Southern portion of the State.
