Resolutions.

Fred. T. Myers, Julius Hirschberg and Joseph A. Edmondson having been appointed a committee by the Directors of the David S. Walker Library Association to draft suitable resolutions on the death of Dr. W. H. Carter, reported the following, which were unanimously adopted:

Dr. W. H. Carter was born in Brooklyn, New York, October 27th, 1829. He became Rector of St. John's Church, Tallahassee, Fla., in June of 1879. He died at Tallahassee, December 28th, 1907, in the full fruition of a useful social and religious life. Since identifying himself with this community, he has been a potent influence in promoting its intellectual and moral welfare. He was one of the organizers of the Library Association, and from its beginning was a director, and chairman of the book committee. On the death of Governor David S. Walker, the founder, and first President of the Association, in the year 1891, Dr. Carter was elected President, and held the position from that time until his death. A devoted lover of books, and a constant student, he brought to the assistance of his associates in the directory of the Library a ripe scholarship and a varied learning, which were of invaluable service to them in the discharge of their duties. He was always punctual, faithful, and conscientious in the performance of every duty imposed; and an unobtrusive but forceful exemplar of devoted service. The occasion of his death is a fitting one for us to express our admiration of his character and appreciation of his worth. Therefore, be it

Resolved That, in the death of Dr. Carter, the Library has lost a faithful friend, the Association a valuable member, and the directors a genial associate, a wise counselor and a helpful coadjutor.

Resolved, That it will be difficult to find one as zealous, as earnest and as wise to fill the vacancy occasioned by his death.

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be furnished the local papers for publication, and a copy mailed to the family of the deceased, as an expression of sympathy from the directors of the David S. Walker Library Association.


