**PROHIBITION IN GREAT CENTERS.**  
Forty-seven great industrial centers... throughout the nation, each with over... 20,000 population, have outlawed the... saloon. Seven of these each numbers... more than 100,000 souls; six others more... than 50,000 souls; seventeen others... more than 25,000. A total population... of nearly 2,000,000 residing in great... cities have rendered their verdict that... prohibition of intoxicating beverages is... right. Over two-thirds of the territory... of the United States is now under legal... prohibition. The tide is rising and will... soon cover our great land as the waters... cover the deep.
