## STATISTICS ON THE NEGRO

More Living in the Northern than in Southern Cities—Comparative Death Rate.

Of late there has been considerable discussion relative to the population and residences of the negro in the United States, many claiming that they were for the most part scattered among the Southern States. It will be a surprise to learn that a late report made by the Census Bureau shows that more live in the cities of the North than in those of the South. The five cities having the largest negro population are: Washington, 86,702; Baltimore, 76,258; New Orleans, 77,714; Philadelphia, 62,613; and New York, 60,666.—In St. Louis there are 85,516, more than 4,000 over the number living in Charleston. The count shows that in the States Georgia takes the lead with 1,034,913 negro residents, followed in numerical order by Mississippi, Alabama, South Carolina and Virginia. In the North, New York leads with 99,232, Ohio following a close second with about two thousand less. The birth rate of the negro shows a marked reduction and the death rate almost double that of the whites, being 39.2 per cent against 17.3 per cent among the whites.


