

## FINANCIAL STATUS OF THE STATE OF ARIZONA

Preliminary figures from the forth coming bulletin pertaining to national and state indebtedness and funds and investments have been given out by Director W. J. Harris, of the bureau of census, department of commerce. The bulletin carries information for the state of Arizona, as well as for the other states and the United States. The data were compiled under the supervision of Mr. John Lee Coulter, expert special agent in charge of the inquiry on the wealth, debt and taxation.

An inspection of the tables for Arizona in the bulletin soon to be issued shows that the records are not complete, no data being obtainable for ten years of the period covered. The bonds show

a general increase from \$633,000 in 1890 to \$3,534,000 in 1913, while the floating debt, though small and changing from year to year, shows a decrease of over 80 per cent for this period.

In 1890 the total debt of Arizona at the close of the fiscal year, June 30, was \$757,000; in 1913 it was \$3,534,000. The population of the state increased from 89,000 in 1890 to 206,000 in 1910.

In 1892 the per capita debt was \$8.33; in 1894 it was \$21.55, an increase of \$13.22, due to the refunding of the county and city debts by the state.

The maximum per capita debt for Arizona was reached in 1898 when it was \$25.24, falling to \$13.02 in 1913. The total increase in the per capita of the debt (less sinking fund assets) from 1890 to 1913 was \$4.44.

Comparing the state of Arizona with the 48 states, we find

that, taking the entire debt (less sinking fund assets) for the 48 states, the average per capita according to the latest report is \$3.52, or slightly more than one-fourth of the per capita debt (less the sinking fund assets) for Arizona. On the other hand, the true state debt of Arizona—that is, the total debt less sinking fund assets, less county and city debt—shows a decrease in the amount per capita from \$8.51 in 1894 to \$393 in 1913. Thus the true per capita debt of Arizona in 1913 was only \$0.41 greater than the average per capita debt for the entire 48 states.

At the present time about 0.2 per cent of the total population of the United States will be found in the state of Arizona, and 0.8 per cent of the total debt (less sinking fund assets) is attributed to that state.


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
