On motion, the Board adjourned until 9 o'clock August 3rd, 1915. August 3rd, 1915, 9 o'clock A. M. Present: R. C. Creswell, Chairman, Geo. W. Hennessey, member and Dee M. Moss, Clerk. Absent, Q. R. Gardner, member.

In the matter of establishment of County road through J. Flanigan's pasture, the Board authorized Geo. W. Hennessey to negotiate with Mr. Flanigan for right-of-way across his land for said road.

County Engineer Perkins made report on unauthorized fenced County road on Showlow-Pinedale road and report was filed and approved.

The Board gave the County Engineer authority to have a field telephone.

The Board denied petition praying for County Road to be altered on the Show Low and Pinedale road beginning at station 11-A plus 1854, thence running northwesterly to an intersection at or near station 12-A of the same road.

On motion the board adjourned until 1 o'clock p. m. 1 o'clock p. m. Present: R. C. Creswell, Chairman, Geo. W. Hennessey, member and Dee M. Moss, Clerk. Absent, Q. R. Gardner, member.

In the matter of the petition for County Road leading east from Snowflake, the board deferred action until correct petition is filed.

In the matter of the establishment of County Road from Winslow to Bruchman's Trading Post, it appearing that the petition, notices, and affidavit of posting notices, appointment of viewers, report of viewers, proof of posting notices of hearing on petition, being duly filed, and of record in the files of Navajo County, Arizona, and this being the day set for the hearing on said petition and the filing of objections and claims for damages, and no objections being made, and no claims for damages being filed, the Board of Supervisors hereby declare and make said road a County Road in accordance with said petition, conditioned on map being placed of record in the County Recorder's office of Navajo County, Arizona and the notes thereof being placed on file in the office of the County Engineer of Navajo County, Arizona.

Communication from Hiram Cheney in regard to change in County road was referred to County Engineer for report.

Regarding the petition for County Road beginning at station 31 M plus 4387 feet of the Holbrook to Ft. Apache road, N. A. Brimhall of Taylor and Geo. Woolford, of Show Low were appointed viewers of said proposed road, to report at the next regular meeting of the Board.

The petition for County Road beginning at the S. W. Corner of Sec. 16, Twp. 10, N. R. 22 E., near Show Low and running to Lakeside, was deferred until the next regular meeting of the Board.

Supervisor Q. R. Gardner, present at 1:30 o'clock p. m. As per published notice, bids for sale of School bonds of School District No. 3, Navajo County, Arizona, were opened and immediately considered with the following results, to wit: Bid of Cutter, May & Company of the city of Chicago, State of Illinois, being the highest and best bid received for bonds of School District No. 3, Navajo County, Arizona for the purpose of purchasing a school site, the construction and erection of a school building and supplying and equipping same with necessary furniture and fixtures, is accepted and approved on the following terms, to wit: Issue \$25000.00, dated September 1st, 1915, 25 bonds in the denomination of \$1000 each. Said bonds being payable as follows: Five of said bonds, numbered 1 to 5 inclusive, payable in five years; five of said bonds, numbered 6 to 10 inclusive, payable in 10 years; five of said bonds, numbered 11 to 15 inclusive, payable in 15 years and 10 bonds numbered 16 to 25 inclusive payable in 20 years from the said 1st day of September, 1915. Each of said bonds bearing interest at the rate of 5 percent per annum, payable semi-annually. Both principal and interest to be payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Navajo County in Holbrook, Arizona, or in the city of New York, at the option of the holder, and the said bidder is to pay for said 25 bonds the par value of said bonds and accrued interest to day of delivery to them in Chicago, free of exchange and collection charges, less the sum of \$900 to cover attorney fees and blank bonds.

The bids on school bonds, District No. 3, of Sweet, Causey, Foster & Company and James N. Wright & Co., both of Denver Colorado, were rejected.

Regarding the appointment of Deputy Ranger for the Southwest part of the County, the Board deferred action until the next regular meeting of the Board.

A. M. Boyer, justice of the peace, appeared before Board and asked for clerk, for the office of the Justice of the Peace at Holbrook. The Board deferred action until its next regular meeting.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned until its next regular meeting.
