Junus Kissey rendered a decision on Friday last in the case of the Territory vs. Gill, for libel, in which the ten lost laws are declared valid. Among these laws is one which provides that a grand jury shall consist of from seventeen to twenty-four men while the grand jury which indicted Gill consisted of but fifteen members, which the judge decided was an illegal jury and all indictments found by it were void. 
