JUDGE KIRSEY has called another grand jury in Phenix to take up the cases which were knocked out by the plea in abatement decision. There will be seventeen jurors this time.

COUNTY warrants are selling in Cochise county for 95 cents on the dollar. This was brought about by the funding bill which will, if it is realized in a practicable shape, next month, cause warrants outstanding to be out a long time before paid.

THERE seems to be a manifest desire among the majority of the members elected to the coming legislature to reduce the expense of maintaining territorial, county and municipal government in the territory. It is to be hoped the legislature will begin its work of reform in its own body by employing no unnecessary clerks and by paying reasonable per diem and no more to those it does employ.—Star.

TERRITORIAL TREASURER SMITH yesterday received a letter from the United States treasurer informing him that the comptroller of the treasury had been instructed to remit to Mr. Smith a check for \$15,000, for agricultural instruction at the State University. The letter further stated that the amount for this Territory was cumulative and would be increased \$1000 a year for the next ten years, the sum reaching \$25,000 by 1900.—Republican.

THE Hon. Thos. Hughes, territorial auditor, arrived today from Tucson to attend a meeting of the loan commissioners, which is in session this afternoon. Applications have been received from every county in the Territory for loans, but nothing farther has been done, and no representatives of counties were present today, as was anticipated.—Phenix Herald.

The outlook for the funding of the indebtedness of the Territory is not very bright judging from the fact that this is the last month in which to perfect the loan, and nothing, as far as heard from, has been done toward carrying it into practical effect.
