\$2,500 REWARD.

Reward Proclamation

To all to Whom these Presents May Come, Greeting.

WHEREAS, It has come to my knowledge from authentic sources that on or about the 12th day of December A. D. 1890 N. H. Robinson and John Bridger were ruthlessly murdered near the line between Mexico and Arizona, in the county of Cochise this Territory, and

WHEREAS It appears from the evidences of reliable witnesses and the report of the Coroner's inquest held upon the bodies of said Robinson and Bridger in the City of Tombstone on the 15th day of December 1890, that the murders were committed by hostile Indian renegades who are absent without leave from their reservation.

Now Therefore, I, N. O. Murphy, acting Governor of Arizona, by virtue of the power and authority within me vested, do hereby offer a reward in the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS (which sum shall be aggregate amount paid under this proclamation) for the arrest and conviction of the murderers of said N. H. Robinson and John Bridger, or for satisfactory evidence that said murderers have been killed during legitimate efforts to capture them, which evidence may consist of the dead bodies of the Indian murderers, or such portion of their bodies as shall be sufficient to satisfactorily prove their identity.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Territory to be affixed.
