FREE COINAGE 16 to 1

We demand the immediate restoration of the free and unlimited coinage of gold and silver at the present legal ratio of 16 to 1, without waiting for the aid or consent of any other nation. We demand that the standard silver dollar shall be a full legal tender, equally with gold, for all debts, public and private and favor such legislation as will prevent the demonetization of any kind of legal tender money by private contract.—Democratic National Silver Platform.

The efforts of the Arizona Republican organs to sidetrack the money money question just now are painful but transparent.

Will the Tucson Citizen enlighten us on how a silver congress can be elected on the Republican national gold platform.

It is announced that Spain does not look for war with the United States. Such being the case, the United States may devote the summer months to the more peaceful pursuit of politics.

The Denver Republican has jumped into the band wagon, fires its McKinley gold bug banner into the ash barrel and hoists boldly the names of Bryan and Sewall at the head of the columns.

In an statistical report just published the number of federal office holders in the republic amount to over 40,000; and those of the states and territories of the Union to nearly 60,000, making a total of about 100,000, or nearly one per cent of the population of the country.

It was reported from Chicago yesterday that a house-to-house canvass had been made among the employees of the industrial enterprises of Ohio, and the consensus of opinion was favorable to silver regardless of party affiliation. There is no doubt, however, that the silver sentiment is widespread, embracing people of all parties, and no parties at all, and for this reason especially an aggressive campaign on the part of the sound money element is not only in order but absolutely imperative.—Philadelphia Stockholder.


