We demand the immediate restoration of the free and unlimited coinage of gold and silver to the present legal ratio of 16 to 1, without any agreement with the leading commercial nations of the world, which we regard as a national disgrace. We are therefore, in favor of the preservation of the present legal ratio of 16 to 1, and we will prevent the devaluation of any kind of legal tender money by private contract." — Democratic platform, Chicago.
