Daily Happenings at the Great Copper Camp.

Hugh Conlon returned to town today after several weeks hard work in the round up. Hugh says a little of that sort of thing goes a long way with him, and he is glad to be through with the job.

Some people are very busy just now prophesying a split in the Republican convention tomorrow. This is only another case of believing that which they would like to see, and don't cut much figure with any one but the parties concerned.

Our leading butcher, Chas. Overlock, formerly of Tombstone, had quite an interesting exhibit in his shop today in the shape of a superbly dressed beef which dressed 950 pounds. Mr. Overlock says this is the largest beef ever dressed in the county, and we guess he ought to know. When we consider that a beef loses about half its weight in dressing we can readily imagine what a monster this one must have been.

The Bisbee Bryan Club turned out in full force this evening with drums, flags and all other necessary features.
