The total amount of money to be distributed by the state to the several schools of the state, apportioned upon the school population, is \$417,548.72.
STATE TREASURER STURGEON has issued a call for state warrants registered from \$0,774 to \$1,250, aggregating \$100,000. Interest on these warrants will come on June 5.

The British government has gratefully accepted the offer by the United States of a warship to bring home the body of Lord Pauncefote, late British ambassador at Washington.
ERNEST WILLIAMS has directed that Adjutant General Corbin, General S. M. B. Young and General Leonard Wood shall be his guests at the German military maneuvers next fall.
The publishers of the History of Nebraska, of which the late J. Sterling Merton was the author, announce that the work will be completed and issued not later than January, 1920.

ARTICLES of peace were signed Saturday last by English and Boer representatives by which the war in South Africa is brought to a close after two years and eight months of conflict, which has cost both sides the loss of many precious lives and millions of wealth.
WILLIAM SCHMIDT has brought suit against the city of Fremont to recover the sum of \$1,000 damages, which he alleges he sustained by falling on a defective sidewalk. His son, William Schmidt, jr., has brought a similar suit for \$5,000, asserting that he was injured at the same time and place as his father, but that his injuries are of a permanent character.
A BILL has been introduced in the house of representatives by Congressman Harlow authorizing the secretary of war to make a study of the width of sixteen feet of the military boulevard extending from Fort Crook to the city limits of South Omaha, at a cost not to exceed \$20,000. The bill provides that the commission of Douglas and Sarpy counties grade the boulevard without expense to the government, and dedicate the right-of-way without cost.

There were some big prizes paid for stock at Kansas City on the 27th inst. A Kansas steer received \$7.00 for thirty prime heavy steers, averaging 1,200 pounds apiece. This price was never surpassed at the stock yards and was equalled only once, on June 10, 1919. Two loads of 1,100-pound steers sold for \$6.50, a record breaking price, and, weight considered, the highest price paid at any market. The cattle were shipped from Walnut Grove, Texas.
A MILITARY balloon was struck by lightning near Ansgberg, Bavaria, one night last week at an altitude of 500 meters. The only occupant of the basket at the time of this occurrence was Lieutenant von Hiller, who was telephoning his observations to soldiers on the ground below him. When the balloon was struck it burst into flames and fell rapidly to the earth. Lieutenant von Hiller had the harness in both feet broken, but escaped further injury.

The career of Mr. Washington was outlined, the hardships he endured, the prejudices against his race, and finally the victories and the honors given him; of his school wholly organized for the benefit to the colored race. ALBERT D. HENCKES.

There is only one way and that by the purchase of Palestine.... Yet even though this movement fails it is the one force that has put a program into the lives of millions of people."

ANNA M'GOWAN.
who stood the highest in her class for the four years in the high school, and who is honored by all her associates for her ability, gave the valedictory. We quote from the latter part of the address: "From thirty-five, four years ago we are now number thirteen.
