Lime-Sulphur Wash for the San Jose Scale

Our experiments with caustic soda during the past year indicate that it is almost useless against the San Jose scale. Used at a strength of 1 1/2 pounds to one gallon of water, it proved ineffective against this pest, while it injured young apple trees seriously.

Recent quotations from wholesale druggists indicate that sulphur can be obtained in barrel lots at 2 1/2 to 3 cents per pound, and as lime is cheap, this wash can be prepared at reasonable cost.

We wish to impress upon fruit growers the necessity of cooking this wash vigorously for at least 35 to 40 minutes.

The addition of caustic soda to either the cooked or uncooked wash, while adding considerably to the cost, has not proven of any practical value in our work, and is not recommended.
