(continued from first page.) ing power of sin, and proceeds to correct the inconsistencies and irregularities of our life as seen by the world.

The indwelling Holy Ghost, like the new sap rising in the tree at springtime, loosening all the dry leaves which have defied the blasts of winter, causes all that is worthless in our lives to fall away by His living, life-giving power.

First, "Not by works lest any man should boast." Having begun in the spirit we are not to end in the flesh. Sanctification is not an attainment but an obtaining. We never attain it by growth, but we obtain it by faith.

Second, Is it a second blessing? It was with the disciples at Pentecost. They had been converted for three years and walking in the highest fellowship with the Saviour; but Pentecost was a second experience, wholly different from anything they had known before.

The two offerings, the "sin offering" and the "whole burnt offering" are again very significant; foreshadowing the two experiences. The sin offering was justification, the whole burnt offering was sanctification, for the whole of the animal was consumed, which would prefigure nothing else than that the whole body, soul and spirit was presented in total unity to God.
