Oakland, Md., Nov. 8.—It has been stated in several leading papers since the election that because of the great Democratic victory in New York on Tuesday last the Empire State would name the Democratic candidate for the Presidency in 1900. This prophecy will not be fulfilled if the senior Maryland Senator's plans, as stated by some of his close friends, are carried out. If some astute politicians are correct in their statements, Senator Gorman will refuse to retire from Maryland politics and will decline to agree with those who considered his defeat on Tuesday last a final knockout for him. One of the shrewdest of the shrewd city politicians said a day or two ago that "we will have this fight all over again two years hence. Gorman has his eye on the Democratic nomination for president in 1900. No appointment or place which he might be able to get outside the State would aid him in this aspiration.
