**DEATH SENTENCE AFFIRMED.**

The supreme court has affirmed the decision of the lower court in which the death penalty was imposed upon Simon Reyes, of Key West, for the murder of Rosa Camera. Reyes pleaded insanity, but the circuit court did not sustain the plea. Reyes was convicted and sentenced to death. The decision of the supreme court leaves no recourse for the condemned man, except an appeal to the pardoning board which will probably be made.

**PRIMARY CHANGES.**

At the meeting of the Democratic state executive committee in Jacksonville last week the following amendments to the primary election law were favored:

That the expense of the primary be borne by the state as in general election.

To submit decision of contests to the circuit judge.

Any person found guilty of offering or giving a valuable consideration for votes subject to fine of not less than \$250 and a jail sentence.

Providing that candidates be required to publish statement of expenses of campaign.

That it shall be unlawful for any church or charitable organization to solicit contributions from an avowed candidate for office.

That the state committee be authorized to name one of the inspectors at each polling place.

That the charter of any organization be annulled upon proof that such corporation contributed in any way to the funds of any candidate.

That no tax collector shall receive poll tax from any man except for his own poll tax.

To redistrict counties so that each district shall have no more than 200 voters.

Amendments proposed to the primary election law that were rejected by the Democratic state executive committee:

To eliminate offices filled by appointment from operation of the law.

To charge ten dollars in addition to the poll tax due for reinstatement of a voter from the registration list.

The recommendations of the state executive committee regarding the primary law will be submitted to the legislature in the shape of a bill embracing the changes agreed upon. Chairman D. U. Fletcher will appoint a committee to attend to this work. Primary advocates will go to the legislature and work industriously to have the amendments made into law. Leading politicians declare that Gov. Broward is very anxious for the evils of the primary to be adjusted, and it is known that some of the suggestions made yesterday are in harmony with his views. Governor Broward wields a strong influence over the legislature and it is known that a decided majority of the lower house is in hearty accord with the governor in almost all of his ideas of state government.



In the last article written to her home paper, The Tribune, of New Hartford, Conn., Mrs. H. R. Jones, the editor's wife, says of Titusville:

Furnished rooms are in great demand and boarding houses daily turn away applicants for accommodations. This is one of the best hunting and fishing sections of the state, beside being one of the most delightful as to climate, with a much longer season than the more southerly resorts, which become intolerably hot before the first of April."

**TO PROTECT FISH AND GAME.**

A petition is being circulated among the registered voters of the county and is being generally signed, addressed to the honorable board of county commissioners, requesting that board to appoint and authorize the sheriff to act in cooperation with the fish and game warden in preserving the game in this county, and that he have power to appoint deputies to assist in protecting game, and in making arrests when the statute relating to game is violated. The petitioners recite that they verily believe that this is essential for the preservation of the game in this county and for the enforcement of the state statutes in such cases made and provided. This petition had about one hundred signatures of persons living in this section this week. Same will be circulated in different parts of the county before being presented to the commissioners, consequently will hardly reach them before the regular meeting in May.
