MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY.

England Pleased With Pauncefote Because He Pleases Americans.

LONDON, March 7.—The St. James Gazette this afternoon, while declaring that the extension of Lord Pauncefote's stay at Washington as ambassador of Great Britain is due to the coming presidential election and "all that goes with this recurring commotion," says: "To Americans Lord Pauncefote's stay will be acceptable, because he has achieved the feat of making himself popular with a success for which there is no precedent since the first British minister was accredited to the United States a century and a quarter ago. To us his continued tenure of office is acceptable because he has pleased the Americans, and it is highly desirable from a business point of view as well as grateful to our feelings that they should continue to be pleased."

Buller's Casualties.

LONDON, March 7.—Another list of casualties sustained by General Buller's forces from Feb. 14 to Feb. 27 shows: Killed, 122; wounded, 573; missing, 14. Of these the losses of the Inniskillings were: Killed, 54; wounded, 162; missing, 22. Dublin Fusiliers: Killed, 15; wounded, 97; missing, 18. Connaught Rangers: Killed, 19; wounded, 105; missing, 1. Royal Irish Fusiliers: Killed, 11; wounded, 63; missing, 3. Scott's Fusiliers: Killed, 13; wounded, 68. With the list of casualties issued Monday, this makes the total cost to the rank and file in the final relief of Ladysmith 1,859 men.

Fighting in the Transvaal.

LONDON, March 7.—A special dispatch from Durban says a flying column of British troops from Zululand has entered the Transvaal and has been daily skirmishing with small parties of Boers. The force consists of mounted infantry, Natal scouts and artillery, all commanded by Major Prondergast. The column first crossed the border on Feb. 23. It now occupies an entrenched position on Catasa hill, 9 miles within the Transvaal.

No Boers Around Ladysmith.

LADYSMITH, March 7.—There are no Boers within 20 miles of here. Plenty of supplies are available and the troops are quickly recovering their strength. Many of the volunteers have been granted furloughs.

Human to 'p' ak on Dispensaries.

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., March 6.—Benjamin R. Tillman, United States senator from South Carolina, has accepted an invitation from the dispensary advocates in this county to make a series of speeches here between now and April 14, when the Democratic primary will be held and at which election it is hoped to secure a direct vote on the dispensary question.

Porto Rican 441 Denounced. NEWVILLE, March 6.—In an interview today Colonel L. D. Tyson, who commanded the Sixth volunteer infantry in Porto Rico, denounced the Porto Rican tariff measure, declaring it an oppression upon the people. He said he and other military men promised the natives a better government, and that again had allowed them free trade. He regarded the president's action in recommending the \$2,000,000 refund as worthy, provided the people had asked it but he said the people wanted no such favors.

Actress' Husband Ill. CHICAGO, March 6.—Captain Hugo de Bathe, husband of Mrs. Langtry, is lying dangerously ill in the British military hospital at Cape Town. A cablegram to this effect has been received by Mrs. Langtry. Captain De Bathe, who is a member of Colonel Kitchener's staff, was stricken with fever shortly after the relieving force entered Kimberley.

Fatal Mine Explosion. MONTGOMERY, W. Va., March 6.—By an explosion of gas in the Red Ash mines this morning 75 men were imprisoned. Twelve men have been rescued. Forty dead have now been taken out and the rescuing party is still at work. Scenes of distress about the mines are beyond description.

Cable to Manila. WASHINGTON, March 6.—The senate committee on naval affairs today ordered a favorable report on the bill to construct a cable to Manila by way of Honolulu, Midway Islands and Guam. It is to be under the direction of the navy department and to be a government cable.

Texas R-publicans Meet. WACO, Tex., March 6.—The Republican state convention met here this afternoon. The gathering was set for 10 o'clock, but was delayed by canuses of the Green and anti-Green factions. There are a large number of contested nominations and the fight for the organization of the convention is very bitter. The efforts of the party leaders now are aimed toward preventing a split, which is seriously threatened. State chairman E. H. R. Green now controls the convention.

Convicts Who Smoke Marijuana. In southern Mexico the jail and prison officials experience great difficulty in trying to prevent the smuggling into those institutions of the seductive marijuana.
