BUBONIC PLAGUE GROWING.

Four New Cases Reported in Honolulu Since March 2. HONOLULU, March 8, via SAN FRANCISCO, March 10. — Four new cases of bubonic plague have developed since March 2. Among those afflicted is Herman Levy, a hotel clerk. His symptoms are of the pneumonic type. The schooner Alice Kimball, from Maui, brings word that there is a suspicious case of sickness in camp on the Kilauea plantation. Encouraging reports come from the outside islands. No additional cases have developed in either Hilo or Kihuna. The board of health has decided to lift the quarantine in both places within a few days.

Story That They Caught and Ate an American Soldier. SAN ANTONIO, Tex., March 10. — In two different letters received in this city from members of the Thirty-third infantry, who got so close on the heels of Aguinaldo in the mountains in the interior of Luzon, comes the story that a member of the regiment, who fell behind while up in the hills, was killed and partly eaten by natives known as Egnotes, a tribe of cannibals.
