Articles of Incorporation of Mohave Printing and Publishing Company. The undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the state of Arizona, and for that purpose do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article I. The name of the corporation shall be MOHAVE PRINTING AND PUBLISHING COMPANY. Article II. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Kingman, in the county of Mohave, state of Arizona, and offices and branch places of business may be maintained at such other places within the state of Arizona as the Board of Directors may determine.

Article III. The general nature of the business proposed to be transacted is a printing and publishing business, and the doing of any other act or thing or things incidental or pertaining to, or growing out of, or usually and commonly connected or associated with the aforesaid business, or any part or parts thereof, provided that the same be consistent with the law under which this corporation is organized.

Article IV.
