OUR NEW FIRE TRUCK.

The new 110-horsepower, six-cylinder fire engine, just received by the Nogales Fire Department, direct from Elmira, New York, where it was made by the American-La France Fire Engine Co., was tried out Thursday by Chief Bracey Curtis and his assistants. The new engine, which is second to none in the state, is a combination hose, chemical and ladder truck. With equipment and twenty-

five men, it can make seventy-five miles per hour, and can with ease climb the steepest grades in Nogales.

The engine is equipped with 1,200 feet of hose, 40 gallon chemical tank, a self-starter, electric lights, fire-bell, electric headlight, 40-foot extension ladder, 20-foot ladder and two scaling ladders, and six hand extinguishers.

It cost \$6,250 and is a credit to the fire department and the town of Nogales.
