STUDENTS MAY ENLIST.

In order to develop as a military asset a large body of young men in the colleges and to prevent unnecessary and wasteful depletion of the colleges through indiscriminate volunteering, the War Department contemplates the establishment at the University of Arizona of a Student's Army Training Corps during the coming school year. This will be accomplished by providing efficient military instruction under the supervision of the War Department. Officers returning from overseas and unfit for further field service will be utilized when available.

All able bodied students over the legal enlistment age of 18, will be encouraged to enlist in the United States Army, while students under 18 will be permitted to enroll for instruction with the unit. The student who enlists thereby becomes subject to actual service at the call of the President of the United States, but it will be the policy of the government not to call them to active service until they reach draft age unless compelled to do so for military reasons.

Enlisted students will be on furlough until called to the colors, and will receive no pay nor allowances except when attending summer training camps, when they will be entitled to transportation and rations. All enlistments will be in the grade of private.

Students may be discharged from the service for good reasons, such as unfitness, misbehavior, dependent relatives, and the necessity of leaving college for causes beyond the student's control. Such discharges will not release the student from liability to draft.

Time allotted to military work will be ten hours a week during the college year, supplemented by six weeks of intensive training in a summer camp. The government will supply necessary uniforms, rifles, and all other equipment so far as such articles are obtainable.


