Street Grade Notice. NOTICE is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, propose to establish the grade of Cedar street at its western terminus, 28 feet above the level of grades.

Street Improvement Notice. NOTICE is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Astoria did on the 30th day of December, 1882, pass an ordinance, entitled "An ordinance declaring the intention of the Common Council of making certain repairs and improvements in a portion of Cedar street, the repairs and improvements to be as follows: All of that portion of Cedar street between the east side of Salmon street and the west end of said Cedar street in that portion of said City of Astoria which was laid out and recorded by John M. Shively in Clatsop County, State of Oregon, shall be repaired and improved as hereinafter provided, and the easements thereon on the adjacent property. The said repairs and improvements shall be made by removing all of the defective piles, caps, stringers and timbers now in that portion of said Cedar street which is between the east side of Salmon street and the west side of West 24th street, and by replacing the same with new and sound fir piles, caps, stringers and timbers, and all such timbers that have been by any means, taken away or displaced, shall be also replaced with new and sound ones; all timbers so replaced to be of the same size and dimensions as those of the same kind now in the street; and said portion of said Cedar street between said east side of Salmon street and the west side of West 24th street shall be replanked over the portion and to the width it is now planked, with new and sound fir planks three inches in thickness and twelve inches wide. That portion of said Cedar street from the west side of West 24th street to the west side of West 26th street shall be repaired and improved as follows: By filling it three feet at the intersection or crossing with West 26th
