RUGBY is situated in Morgan County, in East Tennessee. It is seven miles from Sedgemoor Station on the Cincinnati Southern Railway, running between Cincinnati, Ohio, and Paducah, Kentucky. From the former city Sedgemoor is 221 miles, and from the latter 114 miles.

Letters for Cincinnati and the North should be mailed by 7.30 a.m. Letters for the South by three p.m. Owing to recent arrangements letters for Cincinnati may also be posted at three p.m. These letters will be delivered a few hours after those posted in the morning. A letter carrier daily leaves the Post Office at 12.30 p.m., for Jamestown, Allardt, and places en route.


