### THE FLOURING MILL.

A Much Needed Industry, And a Welcome Addition To the Business Interests Of Anadarko.

The main object of the special meeting of the Commercial Club, last night, was the discussion of the proposition of Kunkell & Son, of Oregon, Mo., to locate a 125 barrel flouring mill at this place. After considerable discussion, it was decided that the proposition submitted by these gentlemen, was one which it would be policy to accept, and the members of the Commercial Club, and those of our citizens who have taken an active part in securing this much needed industry for our city, are to be congratulated upon their prompt action in regard to the matter. A committee consisting of the cashiers of the three banks, also Prof. Thompson and Mr. Milne, was instructed to take the necessary steps toward securing the location for the mill, and as soon as the necessary arrangements have been made, work will begin on the mill, which when completed, will furnish employment to at least fifteen men. Several suitable locations have been proposed, but we are unable as yet, to give any definite idea of where the building will be located. Our citizens are daily demonstrating the fact that Anadarko is destined to be the business center of the new country, and this last acquisition to our industrial enterprises, is but another example of the progressive spirit and admirable foresight for which Anadarko is noted.

### REPUBLICAN PLATFORM.

Below is the Republican Platform Adopted at the Convention March 5.

We reaffirm our allegiance to the principles of the Republican party as promulgated by the National and Territorial platform of the same.

We demand and insist upon the enforcement of the law in every instance without fear or favor.

We favor the completion of the contemplated public buildings and works as speedily as is consistent with business principles and the best interests of the whole people.

We favor the employment of our local people as far as practical in all public work.

That all fines imposed or collected by the city or any of the officers be made a matter of public record.

We demand an economical and competent administration of the affairs of the city and insist upon the nominees of this convention standing squarely upon the principles herein set forth.

The above platform was adopted by the Republican city convention Thursday. It is a remarkable document in more ways than one. No reference whatever is made to the present city administration. No reference is made to the broken promises in their platform they made a year ago. Some Republicans say they could not afford to endorse the present Republican administration, as it would be an endorsement of Hammond, Bradford, et al. who are not in good standing at the present time, because these gentlemen have made an effort to enforce the laws of the city. Other Republicans say "they could not afford to endorse their past record, because it has been corrupt, the law has failed to be enforced, grafting has been the one great object in view. The Police Court record is a fraud upon its face." We presume these charges made by Republicans are true. We noticed that H. D. Crosby, who laid John Wimberly on the shelf, had the platform amended, by inserting in it "that all fines imposed or collected by the city or any of its officers be made a matter of public record." It is a well known fact that this has not been the practice of these gentlemen in the past, and we can't believe it will be in the future when they turn the better element down in their party and show no sign whatever of turning from their evil practices.

What has the Republican party accomplished in the last year that they should ask the support of anybody in the city? They do not in their platform mention one single item that they have accomplished, that entitles them to the support of anyone. They have retarded the progress of our city, no public improvements have been made, electric lights, waterworks and other public improvements are yet in the future. According to their platform they have utterly failed to merit the support of the voters of Anadarko. "By their fruits you shall know them." We must have a change, we want Anadarko to grow, we want a business administration, an honest administration, a progressive administration.
