The board of county commissioners met this 1st day of April, 1907, at 1 o'clock p. m., in regular session. Present, C. C. Fisher, chairman, A. D. Canon and C. C. Leech, county commissioners, also present, Fremont Boyle, county clerk.

The following business was had and done to-wit:

The official reports of G. B. Phelps for quarter ending March 31st 1907 presented and approved.

The following bids for the construction of sidewalks for the county as advertised were opened and read by the chairman. The Connelly construction company (never slip) walk 13 1/4 cents per square ft. and 40 cents for curb per lineal ft.

The Anadarko curb and walk company, sidewalk 14 1/4 per ft. and curb per lineal ft. 40 cents.

L. E. Simpson, mgr crushed granite company, sidewalk 13 1/2 cents ft. curb per lineal ft. 45 grading and filling to grade 25c

Joseph Conley sidewalk 14 1/4 cents per square ft. curb 40 cents per lineal ft.

Out of the four proposals presented and opened that of the Connelly construction company (never slip) being the lowest of all bids offered, the contract for the construction of said walks is hereby awarded to the Connelly construction company (never slip), they being required to give a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of contract.
