Bill Murray has written a letter to some of his friends that he will run for Congress from the New Fourth District. We thought Bill was going to run for the United States Senate but guess he is like the Irishman thought he was taking in too much territory. We are not surprised that the Cuckle Burr Statesman is fighting the repeal as it has been known for quite a while that when President Wilson refused to let him name all the cabinet officers that they had not been on the best of terms and perhaps Murray thinks he is in a position to even up a little.

Quite a little surprise was sprung on the Missouri delegation in Congress when it was announced that Speaker Clark was opposed to the Toll Repeal Bill. This makes the Missouri delegation stand twelve for repeal and counting Speaker Clark three against it. Clark's attitude is not clearly understood as during the passage of the Toll Exemption Bill in the 1912 Congress Mr. Clark did not participate in debate and did not even vote and why when the administration is so anxious to have it repealed, he who had thought so little about the matter when the Bill was up for action in 1912 that he did not even vote on it should suddenly become violently opposed to its repeal. And we can only wonder if he, like the gentleman of Cuckle Burr fame is peeved about anything.

Bob Dunlap, candidate for Governor is strong for the preferential system for nominations. That is the only system that is fair but if it is done by primary it is too expensive and if the elimination is done by convention you might just as well repeal the primary law, still it is almost necessary in order to get good men nominated that some elimination process be had in order that the minority would not be in a position to control. This might be done by a first and second choice vote at the primary but this has its bad features but still we believe it the most practical made of elimination.

THE SPECIAL CALL OF THE GOSPEL AGE

Whoever Hears This Call May Respond to It.

The Church of Christ—Jesus the Head. The Church the Body—Anointed to Be Kings and Priests—Special Training For Office—Who May Qualify For Election—Terms and Conditions to Be Met—Patient Continuance in Well-Doing—Character-Likeness to Christ the Necessary Qualification. Suffering With Christ—Three Classes That Enter the Race For the Prize. Only One Will Be Successful.



May 3.—Pastor Russell, whose free PHOTO-DRAMA OF CREATION is being produced daily in many cities, preached today from the text, "If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, take up his cross and follow Me."—Matthew 16:24.

First the Pastor showed that God had foreseen the entrance of sin and death into the world, and had purposed in Himself before the creation of the world a great Plan for man's recovery from sin and death conditions, to be accomplished through a Kingdom. This great Kingdom will differ from all others in that its monarch will be a King and a Priest. For this reason Christ is said to be "a Priest after the Order of Melchizedek," who was a reigning priest.

The Pastor then explained that God had foreordained that whoever would be appointed to this office of King and Priest must first demonstrate his worthiness by manifesting obedience to the Heavenly Father, even unto death. The first to be given opportunity thus to qualify for this great honor was Jesus, who offered Himself at His baptism. For three and a half years He was thoroughly tested to demonstrate His loyalty to His consecration vow. When on Calvary He cried, "It is finished!" He referred to His sacrifice of Himself, His demonstration of obedience to the Father's will, even to the death of the cross.

The Gospel Call.

Continuing his argument, the Pastor demonstrated that although more than eighteen centuries have passed since God raised Jesus from the dead to be a Prince and a Savior, yet the world is still unsaved. Meantime, he declared, God has been calling out a special class for a special purpose. Those who hear this Gospel call are privileged to become, upon certain conditions, members of this class which God is selecting—this "Body of Christ, which is the Church." Not until this Body, of which Jesus is Head, is completed will God's Plan for the world's salvation be carried out.

The Pastor then stated the terms and conditions of eligibility to membership in this Body of Christ. God extends the invitation, and nominates those who accept it; but each must elect himself by compliance with the terms of the call. This call is a desire to come to God. Some have it from birth; others get it at their mother's knee, or through a hymn, a sermon, etc. Whatever points to Christ as the Way to God constitutes an invitation.

Walking in the Narrow Way.

To those who turn away from sin and accept Christ as their Redeemer, the Savior says, "If any man would come after Me, let him deny himself, take up his cross and follow Me." The Pastor explained that to deny one's self is to give over one's self-sufficiency, one's desire to do one's own will, and to accept instead the Divine will. Whoever does this dies to earthly ambitions, hopes and desires, and in their stead receives Heavenly ones.

The Pastor then showed that to take up the cross is not always understood by the one starting in the narrow way. Gradually he perceives that it is the crossing of self-will with the Divine will. But if his consecration is genuine, the child of God will learn to rejoice in every trial. The Heavenly Father will cause the way to open before him, and will with every trial provide the way of escape.

To follow Christ signifies patient continuance in cross-bearing. Each one in the narrow way must thus demonstrate his loyalty to God and to the principles of righteousness. This does not mean that the flesh must be perfected, but the New Creature—the new will. The unintentional weaknesses of the flesh are covered by the robe of Christ's righteousness. Therefore the New Creature is privileged to grow in Christlikeness.

The Church, Which is Christ's Body.

Whoever takes these steps comes into the spirit-begotten Body of Christ, the Church, declared the Pastor. This spirit-begetting took place at the moment when, having presented their bodies living sacrifices, they were accepted of God. Then they became members of the Body, all of whom have the same anointing as had their Head. This anointing came upon Jesus at His baptism. On Pentecost it flowed down to the Body, the Apostles being the first members. Since then, each one coming into the Body comes under this anointing. Those who press on faithfully unto death will become members of the Body of Christ in glory.

WHO CONSTITUTE ABRAHAM'S SEED

Divinely Appointed to Roll Away the Curse of Death.

Abraham's Seed Twofold—The Spiritual Seed—How the Logos Became the Messiah—Purpose of Jesus' Death and Resurrection—The Spiritual Seed a Company—The Natural Seed of Abraham—How the Blessing Will Come—Israel's Exalted Position in the Kingdom—Position of Foolish Virgins—Loyalty the Test

April 26.—Pastor Russell, whose PHOTO-DRAMA OF CREATION is a wakened much interest. Bible topics preached today very instructive discourse from the text, "If ye Christ's, then ye Abraham's Seed, and he according to the Promise."—Galatians 3:29.

The Pastor first demonstrated from Scripture that mankind are under the curse of death, and that they can only be brought into a new condition. God's purpose to lift the curse is shown in His Promise to Abraham, "In thy Seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed." This Seed will roll away the curse and roll in the blessing of life.

Next the Pastor pointed out the Scriptural evidence that the Logos of Heaven and became a human being of the Abrahamic stock, in order to come the promised Seed. Jesus, according to the flesh, could not be the Messiah, the promised Seed; for, though a perfect Man, He could not have been the Deliverer whom God had promised.

How Jesus Became the Messiah.

Then the Pastor showed that Jesus became the Messiah when baptized John in Jordan. There He presented Himself a living sacrifice, to do a reservedly the Father's will. This meant, primarily, our Lord's death the antitypical Sin-offering. Mankind are under the death sentence pronounced upon Adam; therefore the Redeemer must taste death for mankind before He could ask for their release from that penalty.

Our Lord's ascension was another step in the Divine Plan of salvation. As St. Paul declares, it was necessary for Jesus to appear in the presence of God with the merit of His sacrifice in order that the Father might give the Church the benefit of the cleansings which our Lord had accomplished. Many have not noticed, he claims, that the Scriptures limit the work of the Gospel Age to the Church. The Pastor also showed that as Jesus had become the Spiritual Seed of Abraham through His anointing the Holy Spirit at Jordan, He began a limited extent the work of blessing. But after He had ascended on High He was then the Perfected One, so He Himself was concerned. The speaker demonstrated, however, that the Scriptures clearly indicate that God had purposed that Jesus have company of associates, to be sharers in the great work of human upbuilding. These constitute the Gospel Church who are to be given glory, honor, immortality in the First Resurrection. They also will become, as members Abraham's Spiritual Seed, joint-heirs in the Messianic Kingdom.

The Development of the Church

Primarily, the Seed of Abraham, the Pastor declared, was to be the Spiritual Seed—Christ and the Church the Divine plan. But Abraham's natural seed—the Jews—will also have part in the blessing. This is set forth in Genesis 22:16-18, where God says to Abraham that his seed would be the stars and the sand on the seashore.

The speaker then explained how some from both Jews and Gentiles have constituted this Spiritual Seed. The early Church was mainly of Jewish origin. These had found that they could not get everlasting life by keeping the Law. Therefore, as St. Paul declared, they must become dead to accept Christ as their Sin-offering and consecrate themselves, in order to come members of the Anointed Body.

The Gentiles were never under Law Covenant, the Pastor demonstrated, and therefore they came into Christ merely by presenting themselves as sacrifices as did the Jews. All who so by faith—Jew or Gentile—are grafted of the Holy Spirit to Heavenly hopes and ambitions. Those who thus faithful unto death will receive a place in the glorified Church. This Christ company Jesus was Head, and the faithful in Christ Jesus have been the members since.

The Natural Seed of Abraham

The Pastor then showed that the experiences of the Jews through the Jewish Age had developed a racial class, enumerated by St. Paul Hebrews 11. These Ancient Worthies will receive their promised "better inheritance" in that they will have perfect men; whereas the rest of mankind will require centuries to reach human perfection. This Ancient Worthies class will be associated in the Messianic Kingdom as its seed phase. The Heavenly phase will be invisible to humanity. The world will see the Ancient Worthies—the likeness of God in the flesh.
