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HUERTA TRIES TO PROVOKE WAR

The most serious issue which has so far arisen between Mexico and this country developed last week when an order from one of the ships in the harbor of Vera Cruz, Mexico, who had been sent ashore to the Post Office for the ship's mail and who was in U. S. uniform and who had the official mail bag on his back, was arrested and put in jail by the local (Mexican) authorities. This appears to have been a studied insult to this country on the part of Huerta.

WHAT IT MEANS

The victorious constitutionalists under the leadership of Gen. Villa have been sweeping all before them and are now so close to Huerta's citadel that he realizes that the Insurgents or Constitutionalists will soon overthrow his government unless something can be done to thwart that purpose. Huerta hopes by giving Uncle Sam a few petty insults for the purpose of involving this government in war with Mexico, so that it will result in solidifying the Mexican people behind his government. However, Uncle Sam is aware of the situation and is not going to let the usurper Huerta draw him into a war as a means for maintaining his own blood bought power. The Mexican authorities have interrupted communication by wire with this country and news is now being censored by the Mexican Government, but it is not believed that the people of Mexico will allow their president to use his power for the purpose of bringing on war with us. The Atlantic fleet has been ordered to Tampico, Mexico, and will remain there until Mexico has made suitable apology for her insult.
