INDUSTRIAL ITEMS OF GENERAL INTEREST

Paisley—Flour mill sells for \$12,000.

Bend—New sawmill to be built 6 miles west of here will employ 50 men.

Newport—Auto road to Siletz Bay being opened.

Silver Lake—Recently burned garage to be rebuilt.

Myrtle Point to have new lumber yard and planing mill.

Portland—Public improvement bureau finds job for 4408 in October.

Winchester Bay—Preparations under way for work on Umpqua jetty.

Grants Pass—\$76,443 contract let Portland firm for new Courthouse.

Portland—October bank clearings aggregate \$79,605,993; largest in city's history.

Coos county plans expenditure of \$600,000 in 1917 on permanent road improvements.

Bandon—Preparations under way for construction of \$30,000 dredge for Port of Bandon.

Salem—\$2,530,000 is estimated as total fruit, vegetable, and grain yields in section tributary to here.

Grants Pass—New factory now turning out fine Rogue River Valley sugar as a finished product.

Medford—Irrigation of 16,000 acres in Sams Valley projected involving expenditure of \$200,000.

Grants Pass—10 cars of apples shipped from here Sept. 10, arrive in London and sell for \$3.50 per box.

Wedderburn—Macley estate sawmill will experiment in sawing hardwood lumber from oak logs of this vicinity.

Coos Bay—Hoquiam, Wash. men contemplate establishing shingle mill in this vicinity with 100,000 shingles daily capacity.

Portland—Contracts for construction of 6 wooden motorships have been awarded to American Ship Building company.

Medford—Large sawmill will be built here to operate about Feb. 1, when electric line will tap timber tract on Jackson creek.

Proposals for contracts by foreign interests for ships to be delivered in 1918 indicate no let-up in this industry for some years at least.

The political fight is over and business and industry will be given a chance to catch its breath before Congress begins to legislate and regulate it again.

G. J. Taylor, editor of Molalla Pioneer has disposed of his interests in the Pioneer to Palmer & Palmer, late of Dillon, Montana, to enter the lecture field.

Portland rubber mills contracts 5000 gross of rubber heels at about \$100,000. The company is increasing its capital stock from \$25,000 to \$40,000.

Portland—One contract assured and two or three others being negotiated, all for construction of steel vessels of from 3000 to 4000 tons deadweight.

Baker—Announcement made that erection of large sawmill to handle 124,000 ft. of government timber on Middlefork of John Day river will be started at once.

Albany—Fully \$150,000 worth of clover seed has been shipped out of Linn county this year, most of it from here where it has been concentrated from all parts of the county. About 20 cars ranged from \$6,000 to \$10,000 per car.


