The Republicans of Windham county are here-

Geo. F. Edmunds, Gen. John W. Foster,  
Chauncey M. Depew and Whitelaw Reid.

It is evident that the Democratic follow-  
ers of the Perpetual Candidate are ex-  
periencing trouble at the hands of the New  
York delegates. At a meeting of these  
delegates at the Hoffman House in New  
York city a few nights ago this resolution  
was passed:

Resolved: That this delegation declares its pur-  
pose to urge and vote for the nomination of  
Lusk B. Hill by the national convention of the De-  
mocratic party until he shall be nominated or  
as long as he will permit his name to be used as  
a candidate for the presidency.

It was a characteristic piece of its omni-  
scient wisdom, or assumption, for a  
Democratic party to announce last week  
that Hon. B. D. Harris was the author of  
the communication on the governorship  
question, written from Brattleboro to the  
Woodstock Standard. When Col. Haskins  
made his reply, reprinted in these columns  
last week, he had no idea that Mr. Harris  
was the author of the article in question,  
and the Phoenix is able to state on the  
best of authority that Mr. Harris neither  
wrote nor knew about it.

The new morning daily at Springfield,  
Mass., to be a rival to the Springfield Re-  
publican, has several times been announ-  
ced as an "assured fact," but definite ar-  
rangements were not completed until last  
Friday, when Joseph L. Shipley, for the  
past 10 years the editor and manager of the  
Springfield Union, sold his controlling in-  
terest in that paper for \$50,000, to a syn-  
dicate of Republicans. Elisha Morgan,  
William Whiting of Holyoke, W. Murray  
Crane of Dalton, and W. N. Plynt of  
Munson are among the men interested in  
the purchase. The morning edition of the  
Union will make its appearance about  
July 1. The Republican recognized the  
sale by throwing bouquets at itself in a two-  
column, double-lined editorial. The Re-  
publican as a newspaper fills its field admir-  
ably, but its so-called independence often  
borders upon cynicism. Its course has

aroused feeling among the out-and-out Re-  
publicans of western Massachusetts, and  
the result is the movement just consum-  
mated.
