An organization of Girl Scouts has been formed in Memphis.

The business men of Cass City are backing a big Fourth of July celebration.

Port Huron motor boat owners are planning to organize a motor boat and canoe club.

Rev. M. P. Fikes is holding interesting and successful revival meetings in Brown City.

Nearly all the teachers in the Richmond schools have been re-engaged for the coming year.

Sanilac county has moved forward a peg. Crosswell has the first automobile hearse in the county.

The first matinee horse races in Ar-mada for the 1916 season were held at the driving park on Tuesday this week.

Rev. J. H. Paton, of Almont, for many years preaching monthly in Yale and Peck, is reported as in very poor health.

St. Clair will have beautiful "white way" of four blocks in length when the new boulevard system of lighting is finished.

The Seniors of Brown City high school will give the play "Barret Cox and Company" on Thursday evening, June 8th.

Marlette village marshal is out after all automobilists running without licenses. He arrests the villagers and outsiders alike.

The baby daughter of Thos. Parker of Applegate, was badly scalded last week when a kettle of boiling water fell off the stove.

The big auto parade of the St. Clair County Automobile Club, to be held in Port Huron on June 10th, will be featured in a moving picture.

Marlette's first season out-door band concert last week was a pleasing success in every way. These concerts will be continued during the summer.

The annual field meet of the Sanilac county high schools will be held in Marlette on Friday, June 2. Brown City, Sandusky, Deckerville, Crosswell and Marlette are the schools taking part.

Ernest Jones, well-known horseman and secretary of Tuscola County Horse Breeders' Association, had his leg broken while helping load logs on a car and died next day from internal injuries.

At a meeting of the dry forces of Sanilac county at Sandusky last week, about 100 people were present and the meeting was a very successful one. An organization was effected and officers and committees appointed.
